Dear families,

We've had a wonderful start to the new school year and I'm pleased to report that all the children and staff have returned with smiles following the summer break, with new children and staff settling quickly and already feeling part of this special community.

Here's a few reminders about our school policies.

Ravenshall School doesn't allow children to bring mobile phones on to the school premises, meaning they must be left at home.

In exceptional circumstances mobile phones may be handed in on arrival, meaning phones are collected by staff and held until the end of the school day. This arrangement must be agreed with family and school before being put in place.

In addition, children are not to bring in air tags (or similar) in to school due to potential privacy concerns and ethical considerations. This is in line with local and national educational policy.

The School's uniform policy asks that families work with us to ensure children wear the correct uniform. The uniform is as follows:

- Plain grey/black – Trousers/ shorts or Skirt
- Plain white or burgundy - Polo shirt or Shirt
- Gingham summer dresses may be worn in school colour
- Plain burgundy or with school logo - Sweatshirt, Jumper, Cardigan
- Relaxed dress code (Post 16 students)
- Sensible footwear must be worn at all times
- Sweatshirts & cardigans with the school logo are available from school. Please contact us for details of prices.
- PLEASE NOTE - STRICTLY NO DENIM

As always, there may be exceptions to this due to the nature of individual children's needs which can be discussed with school when required.
