Parents' Consultations – Wednesday 7 May 2025

We would like to invite you to our Parents' Consultation event on **Wednesday 7 May between 3:15 – 6:30pm**. Appointments to see your child's class teacher will be available face to face at the main school site.

The purpose of this consultation is to:

- discuss how your child is progressing towards their accreditations/holistic targets
- discuss any additional support or curriculum adaptations your child receives to ensure they are making the expected progress.
- discuss how you could support your child's progress and achievement.
- discuss any attendance issues
- discuss your child's engagement in learning
- showcase your child's work and some of the activities they have been involved in.

This year, for your convenience we will be combining the event with 'Brighter Futures'. This has been designed to provide pupils and families with an opportunity to talk to key colleges, day services and other professional organisations who may play a significant part in the next steps of our young people in their lives after Ravenshall. This opportunity is particularly relevant to families of pupils in years 9 – 14. You are invited to attend if your child is approaching a transition phase and hope it will provide you with some insightful information prior to your child leaving school.

Following this, a 15-minute appointment time will be allocated to you closer to the day. This will be done on a first come first served basis so please do not delay in making your request.

Please indicate on the form your request for your child to remain in school.
