Dear families,

This week the government has published new guidance for schools on managing the use of mobile phones. This guidance doesn't affect Ravenshall School as we don't allow children to bring mobile phones on the school premises, meaning they must be left at home.

In exceptional circumstances mobile phones may be handed in on arrival, meaning phones are collected by staff and held until the end of the school day. This arrangement must be agreed with family and school before being put in place.

I would also like to remind families about the School's uniform policy and ask that families work with us to ensure children wear the correct uniform. The uniform is as follows:

- Plain grey/black Trousers/ shorts or Skirt
- Plain white or burgundy Polo shirt or Shirt
- Gingham summer dresses maybe worn in school colour
- Plain burgundy or with school logo Sweatshirt, Jumper, Cardigan
- Relaxed dress code (Post 16 students)
- Sensible footwear must be worn at all times
- Sweatshirts & cardigans with the school logo are available from school. Please contact us for details of prices.
