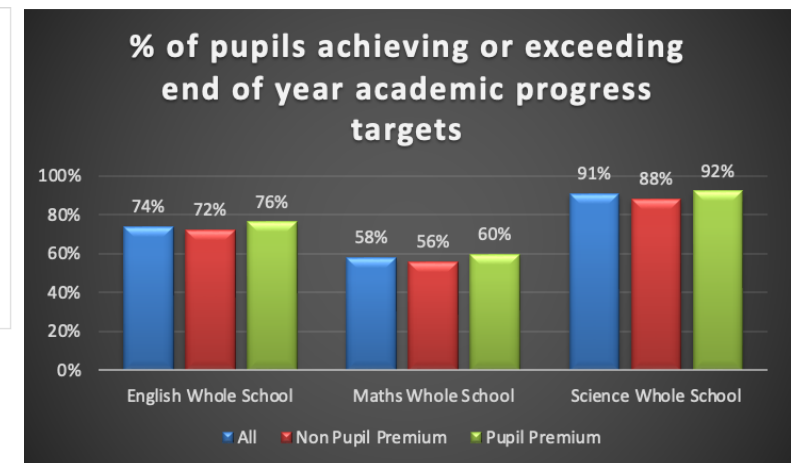
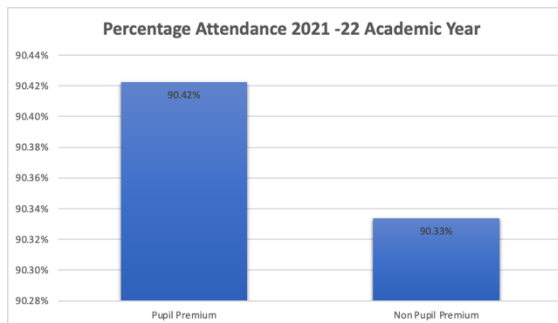


Pupil Premium Impact Statement 2021-22

Strategic Summary: At Ravenshall school, pupil premium funding is used to ensure that pupils are able to achieve academic and holistic progress in line with or better than their non-pupil premium peers.
