

### What is the Ravenshall @ Headfield satellite provision?

A graduated and inclusive learning pathway for up to 10 KS2 pupils with complex SEND and an EHCP.

### Who will lead and teach my child?

This provision will be led and taught by a Ravenshall School Lead Teacher and supported by Ravenshall School Educational Teaching Assistants.

### Where will my child learn?

The pupils will learn in The Base, a large, multi-purpose, designated classroom space at Headfield Junior School. They will have access to a cooking room, a reading classroom, a full working library, a dance studio, huge outdoor spaces, a forest school area, a trim trail and much more.

Pupils will also learn at Ravenshall School, accessing all aspects of the grounds and provision on at least one day per week.

Pupils will have opportunities to learn in the community too including swimming, educational trips and visits.

### Will my child have access to other professionals?

Pupils will access OT, Physio, SEMH support, SALT, medical etc as needed and identified through the annual review process and the EHCP. Referrals will be in line with Ravenshall school policy.

### Whose uniform will my child wear?

Pupils will wear a navy blue jumper with the (optional) Ravenshall logo, white polo shirt and grey trousers, skirt, or pinafore (grey tights). Headfield and Ravenshall colours.



### KS2 special school satellite provision

A partnership between Ravenshall Specialist School, Headfield CE Junior School and Kirklees Council.



### What will my child learn?

Pupils will follow a very personalised and differentiated specialist curriculum, built around their needs, abilities and academic/EHCP targets like every pupil at Ravenshall School.

### How will my child learn?

Pupils will learn in a whole group (up to 10), in small groups and sometimes, one to one. Children will learn in a multi-sensory way with concrete experiences and active approaches.

The best research will be utilised to ensure that children with specific learning difficulties will have access to evidenced based approaches to develop speech, language and communication, learning behaviour and meta- cognitive skills.

### How will my child be assessed?

The Ravenshall Lead Teacher will assess pupils against personalised outcomes in line with the Ravenshall School assessment policy. Progress will be reported in core subjects and towards EHCP targets.

### How will I know what's going on day to day?

The Base staff will be available to communicate via Class Dojo or telephone/email as needed.

All inclusion opportunities and trips/visits will be discussed with families beforehand.

Parents' consultation events and EHCP Annual Reviews will take place in line with Ravenshall policy.

### How will my child be kept safe?

Ravenshall safety procedures will be followed. The Base staff will fully comply with Ravenshall Safeguarding policy.

### Will my child be included with Headfield Junior School pupils?

The Ravenshall Lead Teacher will identify specific, personalised inclusion opportunities for pupils to learn and play alongside their mainstream peers, supported fully by Ravenshall staff. At all times, the needs and well-being of the pupil will be at the centre of these decisions.

### How will my child get to Headfield Junior School?

Transport assistance will be in line with the Kirklees Home School Transport Policy. Headfield Junior School is very close the Ravenshall School.
