Dear Parents / Carers,

In Primary, we provide the children with a small, healthy snack at least once a day. Class teachers use this as an opportunity to provide additional learning for children, such as incorporating maths into everyday life and developing communication skills where children are able to express preferences. They also work on other valuable skills of learning, like preparing a simple snack or simply learning how to feed themselves.

The snacks provide a varied range of food including fruit and other healthy items, to help give the children a balanced diet and opportunities to try different foods.

We ask parents to help pay for these snacks by providing a small amount of money each half term. This half term, we are asking for £7.00 to cover the costs of the daily healthy snacks. This payment can be made via ParentPay online or, if preferred, by using a barcoded letter from school to make the payment at your local PayPoint.

Please note, unfortunately we will not be able to provide healthy snacks for the children in class who have not made this payment, and so they will miss out on this learning activity.
