Dear Parents and Carers

Thank you so much for working with the staff team to get all our pupils safely back to school.

Thanks to your support, our initial plans for a group rota system have allowed us to implement some very effective individual and personalised strategies, ensuring every one of our students has had a positive 'Return to School' experience.

We are now making plans for a full return for all children and young people who attend either the Ravenshall School Main site or Ravenshall's Post 16, PfA Pod.

Following the careful monitoring and evaluating of our current arrangements with the Leadership Team, Kirklees school transport, the Governing Body and by speaking to parents and carers, it has been agreed that the school would implement the following plan which we hope will support the transition of all pupils back into school on a full-time basis.

WEEK 4 This week - w/c 28th September - A & B Groups as planned

WEEK 5 - w/c 5th October - A & B Groups as planned

WEEK 6 - w/c 12th October - School Closed Monday 12th & Tuesday 13th for staff training

BUT, Wednesday 14th October - ALL PUPILS IN FULL TIME and will be taught in class groups

WEEK 7 - w/c 19th October - ALL PUPILS IN FULL TIME and will follow Key Stage timetable

School transport have been informed of our plans. If your child usually travels to school with them, it is expected that they will contact you directly to share 'pick up and drop off' arrangements. If you require more information regarding travel to school plans, please contact the School Transport Team directly on 01484 221000.

Finally, it is **essential** that full contact details are given to the school and that these details are updated and correct with emergency contact telephone numbers.

A contact form was recently sent to you. It must be returned so that we continue to meet our stringent safety plans.

Failure to do this may mean that your child will not be able to join their class on a full time basis.

If you need further information regarding this plan or clarification about any other school issues, please feel free to contact your child's class teacher via the usual way.

My sincere thanks to everyone for your patience and understanding. We appreciate your support in ensuring that Ravenshall pupils have had the best transition period during these difficult and unprecedented circumstances.
